Master Agreement Terms and Conditions:

1. Scope: This addendum covers the Audio Video Equipment and Supplies contract led by the State of Alaska for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating **State of South Dakota** authorized by that State's statutes to utilize State contracts with the prior approval of the State's Chief Procurement Official.
2. Participation: The NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement may be used by all state agencies, institutions of higher institution, political subdivisions and other entities authorized to use statewide contracts in the **State of South Dakota**. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

For internal use by the State: All state agency purchases from this agreement by agencies under the Executive Branch must contact the Bureau of Information and Telecommunications (BIT) for review and moratorium exemption approval. The Contractor will not be responsible to ensure compliance of this requirement.

Political subdivisions of the State of South Dakota may purchase directly from the Contractor according to their own procurement procedures.

The Contractor may, at the Contractor's discretion, extend pricing from this agreement to Indian tribal governments and non-profit organizations in South Dakota. Any sales made to Indian tribes and non-profit organizations from this agreement shall be included in any required reports and shall be subject to the NASPO VALUEPOINT administrative fee.

Liability: EXCEPT AS REQUIRED IN APPENDIX B1 OF MASTER AGREEMENT NUMBER 200000035C, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES, AND NOTWITHSTANDING THE FAILURE OF ESSENTIAL PURPOSE OF ANY REMEDY SET FORTH HEREIN, WILL EITHER PARTY OR ITS AFFILIATES BE LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, EVEN IF SUCH PARTY HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITIES OF SUCH DAMAGES OR IF SUCH DAMAGES ARE OTHERWISE FORESEEABLE. IN THE EVENT OF ANY LIABILITY INCURRED BY A PARTY OR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES HEREUNDER, THE ENTIRE LIABILITY OF SUCH PARTY AND ITS AFFILIATES FOR DAMAGES FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER WILL NOT EXCEED THE DOLLAR AMOUNT PAID BY PARTICIPATING ENTITY FOR THE SPECIFIC PRODUCT OR SERVICE GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM.
6. Value Added-Services: Value-Added Services offered under Schedule C are further defined as stated in this Participating Addendum.

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7. Lease Agreements: Any lease entered into by a State agency, institution, public university, officer, board or commission through this agreement may utilize the lease terms included in the Master Price Agreement at their own discretion. Leases that require authorization by the Office of Procurement Management will be reviewed and approved on a lease by lease basis.

8. Subcontractors: All contactors, dealers, and resellers authorized in the **State of South Dakota**, as shown on the dedicated Contractor (cooperative contract) website, are approved to provide sales and service support to participants in the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement. The contractor's dealer participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.

Orders: Any order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a product and/or service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) the Master Agreement unless the parties to the order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such order.
