

**PARTICIPATING ADDENDUM  
NASPO VALUEPOINT COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM  
Laboratory Equipment and Supplies  
Administered by the State of Idaho (hereinafter "Lead State")**

(hereinafter "Participating State")

1. Scope: This Participating Addendum (PADD) covers the Laboratory Equipment and Supplies contract led by the State of Idaho (Master Agreement No. MA16000234-2) for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating **State of South Dakota**, as provided below.

2. Participation: Use of NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities authorized by an individual state's statutes to use **State of South Dakota** contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

Eligible participants in this agreement include all agencies, institutions, officers, boards, commissions and public universities of the State of South Dakota, and all political subdivisions of the State, including counties, municipalities and public school corporations within the State of South Dakota.

**All state agency purchases from this agreement must be processed through the Bureau of Administration, Office of Procurement Management (OPM). Moratorium exemption approval from the Bureau of Information and Telecommunications (BIT) may be required if the items contain software and or will be connected to a computer. A purchase order issued by OPM will authorize state agency purchases from this agreement.**

Institutions under the control of the Board of Regents may make direct purchases from this agreement using their own procurement guidelines.

Political subdivisions of the State of South Dakota may purchase directly from the Contractor according to their own procurement procedures.

The Contractor may, at the Contractor's discretion, extend pricing from this agreement to Indian tribal governments and non-profit organizations in South Dakota. Any sales made to Indian tribes and non-profit organizations from this agreement shall be included in any required reports and shall be subject to the NASPO Valuepoint administrative fee.

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**3. Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Agreement:**

Prohibited Items: All agencies, institutions officers, boards, commissions and public universities of the State are prohibited from purchasing oral medications under this agreement. This includes oral medications found in First Aid Kits.



Orders:** Any Order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a Product and/or Service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the Order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such Order. All orders issued by purchasing entities within the **State of South Dakota** must include the Participating State contract number: **PADD #16912** as well as the Lead State Master Agreement No. **MA16000234-2**.

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6. Entire Agreement: This PADD and the Master Agreement No. MA16000234-2, together with its exhibits, set forth the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of all previous communications, representations or agreements, whether oral or written. The terms and conditions of this PADD shall prevail and govern in the case of any inconsistency or conflict with the terms and conditions of the Master Agreement, as to the Participating State, and shall otherwise have no impact on the Master Agreement and its exhibits.
